## 25 Ways to Enter Jannah (Paradise) in Islam

Understand that below mentioned 25 regular deeds mentioned in Ahadeeths to enter Paradise are not only things we have to do to get there. These are things mentioned by our beloved Prophet to enhance our chances of achieving Jannah and compensate some of our short comings in fulfilling the commandments of Allah/Quran and our Prophet. Not doing Faraid (obligatory commandments) violating Hagoog ul Ibad (Rights of our fellow human beings) will not help us in getting Jannah with these below mentioned acts alone. Though it is true anyone who has an "iman" of as tiny as a mustard seed his heart will eventually enter Jannah with the Mercy of Allah and intersession of Our beloved Prophet with the permission of Allah, but he/she has to face the punishment of his violation of Right's of Allah and Right's of his fellow being (Unless He sincerely repents with Allah and rectify his dealings with his fellow beings for the rights he violated before the signs of death are visible). Even then Allah (SWT) has full authority to whomever He forgives or punish regardless.

اللهُ فَيَغْفِرُ لِمَن يَشَاء وَيُعَذِّبُ مَن يَشَاء وَاللهُ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرُ

He however has full authority to pardon of punish anyone He pleases. Allah has complete power over everything [Q 2/84] We all want to enter Jannah but are we sincerely striving for it? There are multiple ways to attain the pleasure of Allah SWT and enter His Jannah. Allah SWT has made it easy for us to enter His Jannah but some of us forget this due to an 'attachment' to this temporary worldly life!

Following are some hadiths which will show us 25 ways or good deeds to enter the Jannah. Remember, these are not the 'only' 25 ways and there should be 'sincerity' and 'consistency' in these acts to get Jannat-ul-Firdause (the highest level in Jannah) InshaAllah!

- 1. Whoever meets Allah without ascribing anything to Him will enter Jannah. (<u>Sahih al-</u> <u>Bukhari</u>)
- 2. Whoever believes (has Imaan) in Allah and His Messenger (peace be upon him), and establishes the prayer and fasts in the month of Ramadan, it is incumbent upon Allah that He enters him in Jannah. (<u>Sahih al-Bukhari</u>)
- 3. Whoever says: "I am pleased with Allah as my Rabb, and with Islam as my Deen, and with Muhammad (peace be upon him) as my Prophet, Jannah would be mandatory for him. (Sunan Abu Dawud)

- Whoever asks Allah for Jannah three times, Jannah will say: "O Allah, enter him into Jannah." (Jami` at-Tirmidhi) اللَّهُمَّ إنِّى أَسْأَلُكَ الْجَنَّةَ
- 5. Whoever says "SubhanAllah al-Adthim wa Bihamdihi (Glorified and Exalted is Allah, The Great, and with His Praise), a date-palm tree will planted for him in Jannah. (Jami` at-<u>Tirmidhi</u>)

- Allah has Ninety Nine Names, one hundred minus one, and whoever believes in their meanings and acts accordingly, will enter Jannah. (<u>Sahih al-Bukhari</u>) Visit: <u>99 Names of Allah</u>
- 7. Indeed, truthfulness leads to righteousness and indeed righteousness leads to Jannah. (<u>Sahih al-Bukhari</u>)
- 8. Whoever builds a Masjid seeking by it the Pleasure of Allah, Allah will build for him a similar place in Jannah. (<u>Sahih al-Bukhari</u>)
- 9. Whoever repeats after the Mu'adthin (the caller to prayer) from his heart (i.e., sincerely) will enter Jannah. (<u>Sunan an-Nasa'i</u>)
- 10. Whoever calls the Adhan for 12 years, Jannah will become mandatory for him. (<u>Sunan</u> <u>Ibn Majah</u>)
- 11. Whoever prays the two cool prayers (Asr and Fajr) will go to Paradise. (<u>Sahih al-</u><u>Bukhari</u>)
- 12. Allah will prepare for him who goes to the mosque (every) morning and in the afternoon (for the congregational prayer) an honorable place in Paradise with good hospitality for (what he has done) every morning and afternoon goings. (<u>Sahih al-Bukhari</u>)

- 13. Any one performs the ablution perfectly and then offers 2 rak'ahs of prayers concentrating on them with his heart and face, paradise will necessarily fall to his lot. (Sunan Abu Dawud)
- 14. Whoever prays 12 Rak'ah in the day and night, a house in Jannah will be built for him. (Sunan an-Nasa'i)

- 15. Whoever takes a path in search of knowledge, Allah will make easy for him the path to Jannah. (Jami` at-Tirmidhi)
- 16.I saw a man going about in Jannah (and enjoying himself) as a reward for cutting from the middle of the road, a tree which was causing inconvenience to the Muslims. (<u>Muslim</u>)
- 17. Whoever can guarantee (the chastity of) what is between his two jaw-bones and what is between his two legs (i.e. his tongue and his private parts), I guarantee Paradise for him. (<u>Sahih al-Bukhari</u>)
- 18. Anyone whose soul leaves his body and he is free of three things, will enter Jannah: Arrogance, stealing from the spoils of war, and debt. (<u>Sunan Ibn Majah</u>)
- 19. Whoever raises two girls then I and he will enter Jannah like these two (Prophet indicated with his two fingers). (Jami` at-Tirmidhi)
- 20. Whoever visits an ailing person or a brother of his to seek the Pleasure of Allah, an announcer (angel) calls out: "May you be happy, may your walking be blessed, and may you be awarded a dignified position in Jannah". (Jami` at-Tirmidhi)
- 21. Allah guarantees him who strives in His Cause and whose motivation for going out is nothing but Jihad in His Cause and belief in His Word, that He will admit him into Jannah. (Sahih al-Bukhari)
- 22.O people, spread the Salaam (greetings), feed the hungry, and pray while the people are asleep, you will enter Jannah in peace. (<u>Sunan Ibn Majah</u>)
- 23. (The performance of) Umrah is an expiation for the sins committed between it and the previous Umrah; and the reward of Hajj Mabrur (i.e., one accepted) is nothing but Jannah. (<u>Sahih al-Bukhari</u>)
- 24. Whosoever last words are:

## LA ILAHA ILLALLAH

will enter Paradise. (Sunan Abu Dawud)

25. Prophet Muhammad (ﷺ) said: If somebody recites this invocation (*given below*) during the day, and if he should die then, he will be from the people of Jannah. And if he recites it in the night, and if he should die on the same day, he will be from the people of Jannah." (Jami` at-Tirmidhi)
